Course Description:

This one day course reviews all of the ISO 9001:2015 requirements. The goal is to spend a limited amount of time on introductions and transition but to spend the full value of the course reviewing the requirements. The review will cover interpretation, application, minimum compliance, best practice, evidence, auditing, etc.

Note that this course is based on the FDIS version of the standard. The final version of the ISO 9001:2015 standard may change slightly from the FDIS version but changes can only be typographical, grammar, translation and minor in nature. The FDIS standard is complete enough to review and make decisions about ISO 9001:2015 transition for your organization.
